Counseling Policy

As a District, we understand that the pressures upon our credential holders may at times result in the need for professional counseling. To

that end, we offer provision for counseling with the understanding that these are meant to be guidelines when there is no credential matter involved.

Purpose of Counseling

1. To ensure the spiritual, mental, emotional and physical health of our credential holders

2. To be restorative, not punitive

3. To be pre-emptive vs reactive

Process

In an effort to properly monitor those approved for counseling while at the same

time maintaining individual confidentiality, and to streamline the accounting process, these guidelines have been established:

1. Credential holder (or family member) contacts presbyter of their choice requesting counseling

2. The presbyter assigns a confidential code to the individual. Only the code is given to the District Office for tracking (no names).

3. The individual goes to the approved counseling centre and gives them their confidential code for billing purposes. No names are to be on the counseling bill received at the District.

4. The purpose of the counseling is known only to the counselor.

5. The costs for the counseling will be shared 50-50 by the district and the individual

6. A maximum of eight sessions will be

cost-shared by the District. If the counselor feels more sessions are required, reapplication will need to be made with the approving presbyter.

7. Specific concern will be given for the spouse and children of credential holders as well.

8. A progress report may be requested

Pre-emptive counseling is different from and not directly related to mandated counseling provided through the Credential Restoration Program.

Should there be issues that affect credential matters, the District increases their share of the cost.
